Why teach 'Workplace Hazard Awareness'?

Accidents at work are more likely to happen to under 24's than any other age group. This course equips people with a basic awareness of hazards and how to deal with them, and gets them thinking about why working safely is so important.

It is aimed at people who are starting out in the working world, on work experience, in a part time job or just about to take their first full time role.

Research shows that when people first start work they're at their most vulnerable. They may not have the skills, or understand the workplace, they're probably not aware of the hazards they'll face and they may not have the confidence or social skills to question what they are asked to do.

The "WHAC" course focuses on helping young people to:

- Recognise the hazards they may come across at work
- Assess who could be harmed and how
- Decide on the likelihood of an accident happening

As well as teaching the practical skills of hazard spotting, the course aim to help young people respond in the right way to hazards.

WHAC is designed for students at Key Level Stage 4 of the National Curriculum.
